



PRIVACY POLICY

Your Privacy

Out of the Pit is committed to protecting and honouring the privacy of visitors to our website. This policy sets out how we handle clickstream data, cookies and email addresses.

You have the right to access and request correction of any personal information concerning you pursuant to Australian Privacy legislation.

You also have the right to request destruction or deletion of any information concerning you pursuant to Australian Privacy legislation.

Clickstream Data

Clickstreams are the paths a user takes when navigating a web page or the internet in general.

When you visit our website, our Internet Service Provider makes a record of your visit and logs the following information for statistical purposes - the user's server address, the user's top level domain name (for example .com, .gov, .au, .uk, etc), the date and time of visit to the site and the type of browser used.

Cookies

A cookie is a short piece of data that is sent from a web server to a web browser on the user's machine when the browser visits the server's site. The cookie is stored on the user's machine, but it is not an executable program and cannot do anything to your machine.

Whenever a web browser requests a file from the same web server that sent the cookie, the browser sends a copy of that cookie back to the server along with the request. In this way, the server knows you have visited before and can coordinate your access to different pages on its website. A server cannot find out a name or email address, or anything about a user's computer, by using cookies.

Email Addresses

If you send us an email message, we will only record your email address for the purpose for which you have provided it. We will not use your email address or any of your personal details your email contains for any other purpose without your prior consent and we will not disclose your email address without your consent. Electronic mail submitted to Out of the Pit is handled and saved according to the provisions of Australian Privacy legislation.

Personal Information

Personal information will be collected when you register your details via the web site. You have a choice upon registration to make this information available publicly to other registered users or to keep it private. Mandatory information for registration is: name, gender, location and e-mail address with option to join the website mailing list. Further information may be provided on the discretion of the user, and may only be viewed by the system administrator. All information is stored in an encrypted database on a secure server, based in the USA.

Registered users will be able to view all other users' mandatory information and also that which they have chosen to make public. By registering, users agree to the terms and conditions outlined in this document.

Out of the Pit will not sell, rent or disclose your personally identifiable information to anyone without your prior consent, unless it is required to respond to subpoenas, court orders or legal processes.
